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Why Spain for

Transport and Logistics?

Spain stands out in Europe, as it does in the World, for its extensive network of air, land, rail and maritime infrastructure and the high quality service it provides.

- The Transport sector accounts for 4.4% of Spain's GDP (2022).
- Industry revenue amounted to €149 billion in 2022.
- The industry creates almost a million jobs.
- There is a heavy business concentration and in excess of 218,000 firms linked to the industry.
- Around 2.15 billion tons of goods transported in 2022, 73% being for the national market and 27% for the international one.

A geostrategic location

Spain is a **prime location** in Southern Europe for the transit of goods, acting as a redistribution centre for EU foreign trade with the rest of the world.



Extensive transport infrastructure network

Spain has some of the best infrastructure in the world:

One of Europe's leading **high-speed rail systems**, with over 3,900 km in operation.

46 ports located on its more than 8,000 km of coastline, of which:

• Bahía de Algeciras, Valencia and Barcelona are among the **top 10 in Europe for container traffic and port liner shipping connectivity** (LSCI, UNCTAD).

• Barcelona is Europe's **number one port** for cruises and the world's number seven.

Europe's largest and most extensive express road network with over 17,550 km.



Global competitiveness

Spain is ranked **13**th (among 160 countries) **in the world** in the latest Logistics Performance Index published by the World Bank (2023).



TEN-T Framework

Two of the nine European multi-modal

corridors (the Atlantic and the Mediterranean) in the Trans- European Transport Network (TEN-T) run through Spain.

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Major market for production and consumption

Spanish foreign trade, the main **engine of transport and logistics, represents over 65%** of the country's GDP. In 2023, goods exports amounted to €354 billion and imports €391.8 billion, mainly driven by the automotive, pharmaceutical, and chemical industries.

Average annual **growth of around 15% in 2023** was recorded in internet and e-commerce sales in Spain. Half of those sales are to other countries.



Large number of logistics platforms

Spain has more than **279 logistics parks**, covering around 82.9 million sq.m. (2022), mainly linked to maritime (48%) and road transport (41%).
